
New school board leaders appointed

By state law, all public school boards in the state of Pennsylvania have to elect officers for the new year by the first week of December.

Also in a 5-4 vote, Frank Koziol was named the board's vice president. Former board member Sue Barrett previously held the seat.

The board also re-appointed the firm of Begley, Carlin and Mandio as the district solicitor in a 5-4 vote majority approval. The same four board members voted against all three motions.
