

## Board approves acting superintendent

### NESHAMINY

The Neshaminy school board Tuesday night unanimously approved assistant superintendent Lou Muenker as the acting superintendent.

Muenker, who also served as director of human resources, is temporarily taking over for former Superintendent Paul Kadri, who left the district for a similar job in Groton, Conn.

Board members had previously announced that Muenker would be Kadri's temporary successor. Officials have also said they will search for a permanent replacement.

Muenker's term will automatically expire in one year whether the board elects a superintendent or not, according to Tuesday night's motion.

"I will sit in this chair as long as you wish," said Muenker. "Business has not stopped. We have a lot in front of us. Thank you for your confidence ... and I will try to do my best to fulfill the obligation."

Muenker grew up in Upper Southampton. He started as a Philadelphia school counselor, then migrated back to Bucks County in similar positions in Bensalem, then as an administrator in Neshaminy. He's spent 18 of his 35 years in public education in Neshaminy.

Muenker also thanked Kadri, who was not present at the meeting, for his service and wished him well.
