Finance director resigns

MIDDLETOWN

Middletown Finance Director Donna Caracappa has resigned after less than six months on the job.

Reached Monday, Caracappa confirmed the resignation, effective on Friday, but declined to comment further. She is the former Penndel tax collector and was hired in Middletown on April 20 at a salary of \$56,575.

The Courier Times was unsuccessful in its attempts to reach township Manager Ray Stepnoski or supervisors' Chairman Robert McMonagle for comment. Supervisor Chuck Thompson said it was a personnel issue and declined to comment.

Thompson didn't think Caracappa's resignation would be a major hindrance in putting together the township budget for 2009.

"The last I understood, Ray [Stepnoski] was in pretty good shape as far as the budget goes," Thompson said.
