## Chief McKenna works final shift

Middletown Chief Frank McKenna radioed in his last time Saturday night.

After 51 years and eight months, McKenna, 73, has officially retired. For the last week he stayed to mourn the loss of one of his officers, Chris Jones, who was the first officer in the department's 57 years to be killed in the line of duty.

McKenna joined the Middletown force April 19, 1957, and was the seventh officer in the history of the department.

For his last four years as chief, McKenna was the longest-serving police officer in the state. He radioed in to Bucks County one last time about 8:45 p.m. Saturday night and was met with well-wishes radioed back from officers in surrounding departments.
